What is the Housing Tahoe Partnership?

- South Shore version of MHC. Tahoe Prosperity Center is the Convener and Facilitator of the Partnership.
- Began as an outcome of the El Dorado County Government Housing Task Force meetings.
- We coordinate with Mountain Housing Council regularly on policy, funding opportunities and communication.
- Ultimate goal: ensure housing opportunities for residents and workers are available throughout the Tahoe Region.

Vision:

Transforming local housing options so that residents and workers can live, work and thrive in Lake Tahoe.

Mission:

Accelerating housing solutions to produce, maintain, upgrade, reuse and unlock homes attainable for residents and workers in Lake Tahoe.

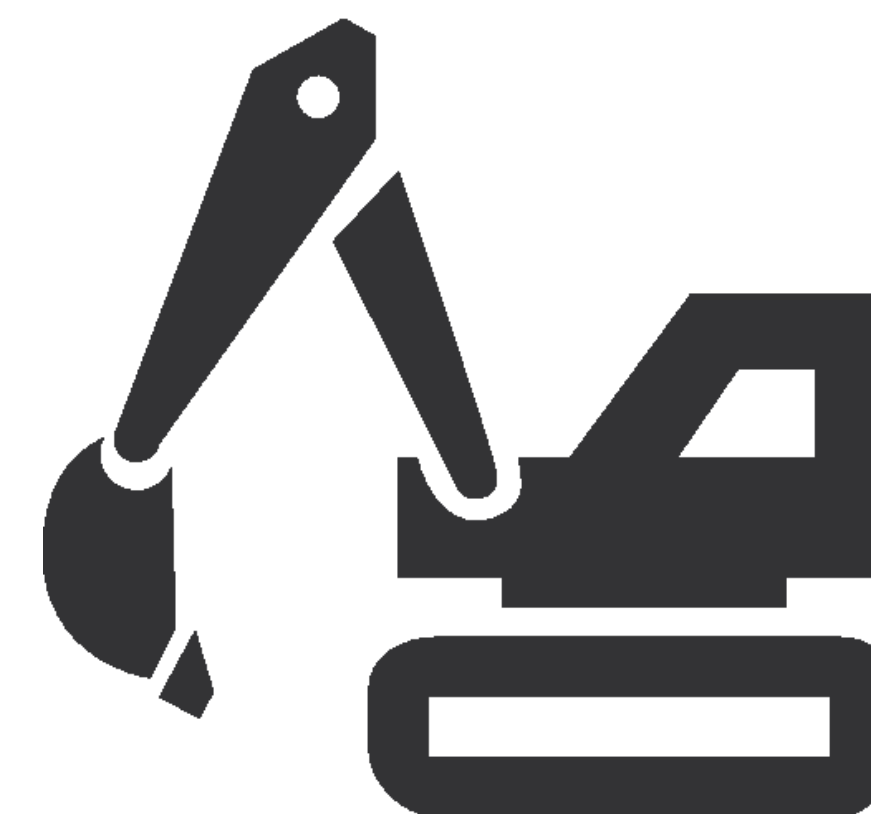

Outreach





Policy

- Educated on housing programs in peer resort communities and key components for success.
- Prioritized housing strategies to pursue from a Toolbox of 39 options enacted in other resort communities, covering six Policy categories: NO SILVER BULLET!
- Drafted reduced parking policy recommendation as first prioritized strategy.
- STPUD adopted policy change on sewer transfers and fees to encourage affordable/workforce housing.

Community Outreach



- Wrote three newspaper columns and shared local resident's stories about housing on social media.
- Supported development of Tahoe Home Connection (TaHoCo) to unlock second homes for seasonal and long-term workforce.
- Conducted outreach to link local motel owners with employers and LTCC for housing.
- Holding first neighborhood housing meeting on Nov 8th (Bijou Community)



Finance

- Completed ten case studies and financial pro-formas on local demonstration project site proposals.
- Reviewed three case studies from other regions on modular housing project proposals.
- Facilitated discussions for potential LTCC student housing project based on their Request for Information (RFI).

Development



- Met with ten housing developers and interested local land-owners about options for potential projects.
- Mapped local land availability via Google Earth and PDF to review options for future projects (City and TRPA).
- Met with national housing builders to gather input for future housing projects in the region.

Next Steps:

- Finalize specific goals and actions for each workgroup.
- Advocate for regional South Shore Needs Assessment and Action Plan to be completed in 2019.
- Continue making progress and keep the community engaged and participating!
